Average cost including pre surgery work up is: \$3,000 - 10,000

### Chronic Conditions

Allergies and Skin Conditions: from \$150 – 200 per month

**Gastrointestinal Issues:** from \$50 per month

**Ear Issues and Infections:** \$200 per occurrence

Dry Eye treatment: \$250 - 2,500\* if surgery required

#### Breeder Price

**Puppies:** \$3,000 - 15,000

**Adults (over 6 months):** \$1,000 - 3,000

## Reproductive Health

Desexing: \$300 - 600

C-section for mother dogs: \$600 - 2,000

## Other Possible Surgeries

Intervertebral
Disc Disease (IVDD):

\$1,500 - 4,000

Cherry Eye: \$400 – 1,000 depending on severity.

**Entropion**: \$500 – 1,500

Chest Bone Deformity: \$200 - 5,000
